

Scholarship Application

The CREW Boston Education Foundation, established in 2009 as a 501(c) (3) charitable foundation of CREW Boston, is an endowed fund that will support the CREW Boston Educational Foundation Scholarship. The scholarship is awarded to a female student entering her junior year, senior year or graduate program at an accredited college or university based in New England. The student must demonstrate an interest in pursuing a career in the commercial real estate industry through her course studies and/or internships in a commercial real estate firm. The 2016 scholarship is expected to be \$5,000.

APPLICATION CRITERIA:

- The applicant must be a female student in good standing entering her junior year, senior year or a graduate program at an accredited college or university in the New England area.
- The applicant must demonstrate an interest in pursuing a career in commercial real estate, through course work and/or work experience.
- The applicant must be willing to have her name and town/city appear in promotional announcements by the CREW Boston Educational Foundation or CREW Boston.
- The applicant must submit the application for consideration by January 31, 2016
