

Scholarship Application

The CREW Boston Education Foundation, established in 2009 as a 501(c) (3) charitable foundation of CREW Boston, is an endowed fund that will support the CREW Boston Educational Foundation Scholarship. The scholarship is awarded to a female student entering her junior year, senior year or graduate program at an accredited college or university based in New England. The student must demonstrate an interest in pursuing a career in the commercial real estate industry through her course studies and/or internships in a commercial real estate firm. The 2019 scholarship will be at least one \$10,000 scholarship.

- The applicant must submit the application for consideration by February 28, 2019
