The CREW Boston Educational Foundation Scholarship seeks to support and empower promising female students who demonstrate an interest in a career in commercial real estate. In addition to providing financial support, the Scholarship provides mentorship, networking and access to CREW Boston's programming. The 2026 Foundation scholarship awards range from \$2,500 to \$10,000.

ELIGIBILITY:

- Female student in good standing currently enrolled in sophomore, junior, or senior year or a graduate program at an accredited college or university in New England
- Demonstrated interest in pursuing a career in commercial real estate through prior course work, internships and/or other experiences
- Applicant must be willing to have her name and town/city appear in promotional announcements by the Foundation and/or CREW Boston
