

Scholarship Application

The CREW Boston Educational Foundation (Foundation) was established in 2009 as a 501(c)(3) charitable foundation to encourage and support female students to pursue a career in commercial real estate through the CREW Boston Educational Foundation Scholarship (Scholarship). The Foundation was created to support CREW Boston's mission, the region's leading professional organization with over 500 members that promotes the advancement and parity of women within the commercial real estate industry.

The Scholarship is awarded to any female student in her junior year, senior year or graduate program at an accredited college or university based in New England. The student must demonstrate an interest in pursuing a career in the commercial real estate industry through her course studies and/or internships in a commercial real estate firm. The 2021 scholarship will be at least one \$10,000 scholarship.

APPLICATION CRITERIA:

- The applicant must be a female student in good standing in her junior year, senior year or a graduate program at an accredited college or university in the New England area.
- The applicant must demonstrate an interest in pursuing a career in commercial real estate, through course work and/or work experience.
- The applicant must be willing to have her name and town/city appear in promotional announcements by the CREW Boston Educational Foundation or CREW Boston.
- The applicant must submit the application for consideration by February 28, 2021

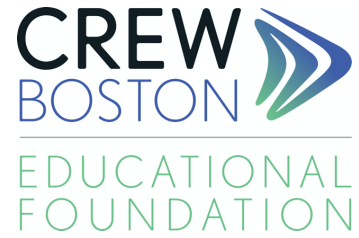
